

## **BRR 2021 COVID Policies (Updated 5/24/21)**

In addition to our normal safety procedures, we are encouraging all participants to follow the safety guidelines below.

### **Basics for Volunteers:**

- Masks: The State of Nevada currently does not require fully vaccinated individuals to wear a mask inside or outside, thus masks will not be required for those who are fully vaccinated. We are still encouraging participants to wear a while gathered 6 ft from other participants who are not part of your “family unit.”
- If you are sick or not feeling well, please stay home!
- If you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID or is showing COVID symptoms, please stay home!
- If you test positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the event, please contact the group or agency with which you were participating

### **Vehicles & Group Rides**

- At this time, partner groups will not be providing rides to participants. We understand that this will create a barrier for some participants and we are sorry for the inconvenience.

### **Camping, Food, and Group Meals**

- This year’s Black Rock Rendezvous *will not include any group camping, food, or group meals* such as the Dutch Oven Competition
- Participants are encouraged to camp on their own with their family units
- Participants must bring their own snacks & lunch for the events.

### **Shared Items, Gear, and Tools**

- Water: We encourage all participants to bring more than enough water for themselves
- Sunscreen: Please bring your own. There will be some small individual packets of sunscreen available for emergencies.
- Gloves: We encourage everyone to bring their own gloves for the project. If needed, gloves will be available to borrow, but, we ask that everyone keep track of their own pair and not trade throughout the day
